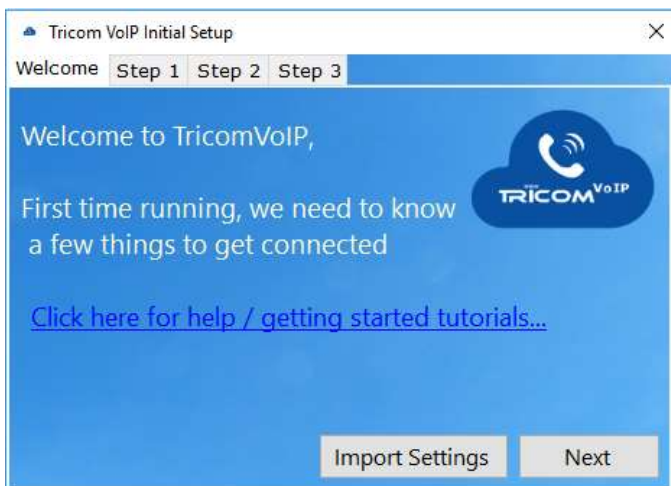


1. Run TricomVoIP.msi and complete the install.



2. Click finish to launch TricomVoIP.




3. Click Next or Alternatively import settings

7. Change default AMI port if required. (Proxy server only)
8. Click Test Connection.
9. If successful – Click next.
10. Enter your display name, extension and DDI if you have a direct dial number.

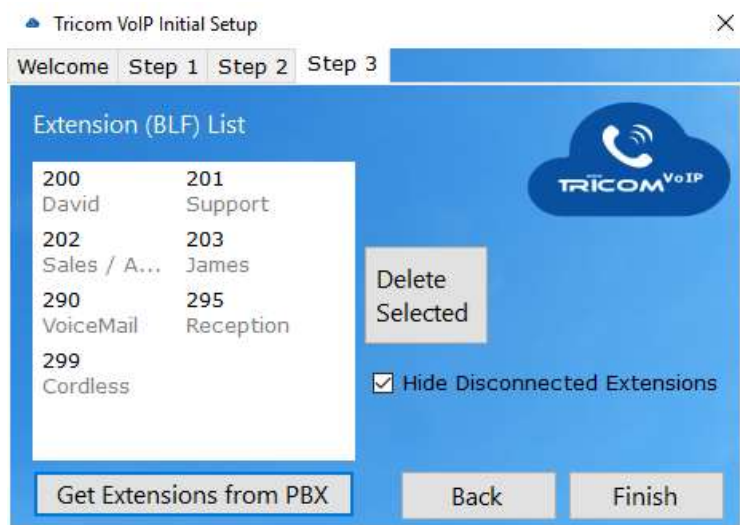
